
BYOD (Bring Your Own Device)

- Students are permitted to use their own device at the teacher's discretion.
- If you are using your device at an inappropriate time, your teacher may take the device to the front office and call your parent to pick it up. There is no charge.
- Personal devices are still subject the PISD AUP policy.

It is at the teacher's discretion when you will use the devices in school.



You may NOT use your device in an area that says No Cell Phones or the classroom stoplight is on RED!



You must have teacher permission to use your device. No use of devices in bathrooms or taking video/pictures of other students without permission.

- You must use the PISD Wireless
 Network in order to access the Internet.
 You may NOT use your personal data
 plan.
- You must login using your PISD account. You may NOT use your personal gmail account.

Violations

- Playing unauthorized games.
- Off task on another website.
- Inappropriate content
- Cyberbullying
- Chatting in class, including Chat Docs
- Use of Social Media in class
- Inappropriate handling of device
- Using personal login instead of school login
- Unauthorized downloading of any software
- Attempting to access blocked sites
- Food or drink near the device
- Changing settings of the device
- Not logging off of device (Google for iPads)

Consequences

- **Step 1:** Verbal Warning
- **Step 2:** Lose Device until end of class period
- **Step 3:** Device taken to office until end of the day
- **Step 4:** Parents contacted to pick up device on the third time it is taken to the office
- **Step 5:** Loss of privilege in all classes for extended time, parent contact, and principal referral
- The severity of the violation can result in heightened consequences. Also, multiple violations from multiple teachers can result in heightened consequences.
