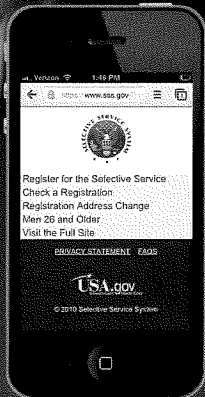




# REGISTERING IS NO BIG DEAL. NOT REGISTERING CAN BE.

# SELECTIVE SERVICE IS IMPORTANT TO AMERICA

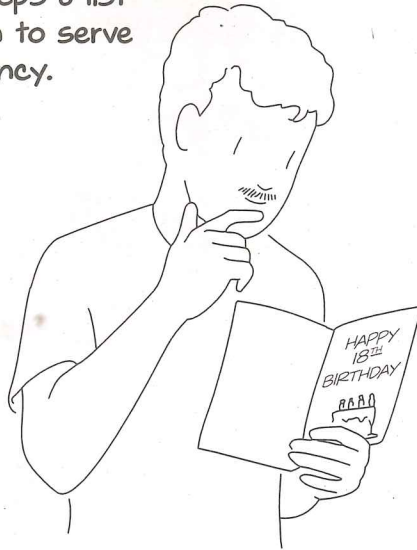
The Selective Service System keeps a list of people who might be called on to serve our country in a national emergency.

## YOUNG MEN MUST REGISTER -- IT'S THE LAW

Just fill in a simple registration form within 30 days of your 18th birthday. If you're a resident of the U.S. you must register, even if you're:

- from another country and not a U.S. citizen
- living in the U.S. illegally.

If you're in a hospital, prison or other institution when you turn 18, you have 30 days to register after being released.

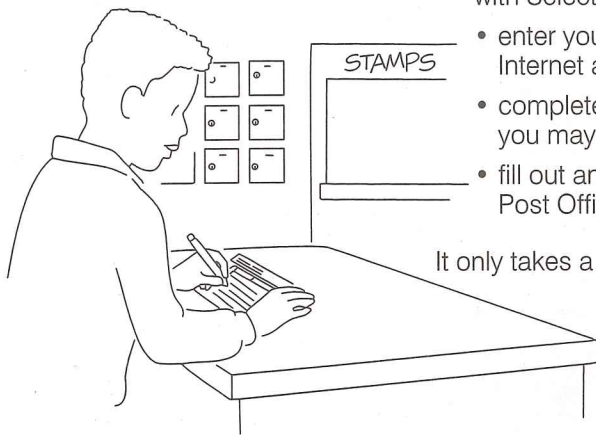


## IT'S EASY TO REGISTER

with Selective Service. You can:

- enter your information via the Internet at: <http://www.sss.gov>, or
- complete, sign and return the card you may get in the mail, or
- fill out an SSS registration form at a Post Office.

It only takes a few minutes to register.



Registering with Selective Service does not mean joining the military!

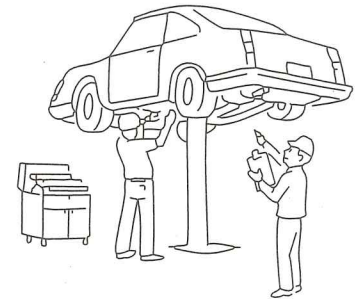

# IT'S IMPORTANT TO YOU, TOO!

Registering with Selective Service can open doors for you. For example, you must be registered with Selective Service to be eligible for:



## STUDENT FINANCIAL AID

Students who aren't registered won't qualify for federal student aid and grant programs.

## FEDERAL JOB TRAINING

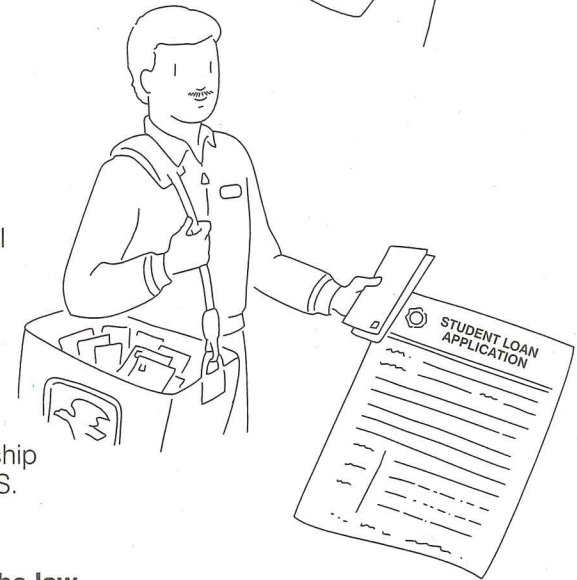
The Job Training Partnership Act (JTPA) offers programs that can train you for jobs such as:

- auto repair
- carpenter
- TV and radio repair
- electrician.



## FEDERAL JOBS

For example, you must be registered with Selective Service to work for the federal government in jobs such as postal worker, computer programmer and others.



## CITIZENSHIP

You must be registered to receive United States citizenship if you were not born in the U.S.

## AND REMEMBER --

not registering is against the law.

So, do your country -- and yourself -- a favor. Register with Selective Service within 30 days of your 18th birthday.
