## GAME NIGHT FOOTBALL PASSES

### **Visitor Passes:**

The visiting team will provide a copy of their own sideline pass. Prosper ISD will police the sideline and remove anyone who does not have the school-approved pass. These passes should cover the following personnel:

- Athletic/School Admin needing sideline access
- Team Physician needing sideline access
- School photographers/videographers
  - Photographers are not allowed to stand, photograph, or film from the end-zone area of the field without authorization from PISD.
  - All photographers must be approved by the head coach, athletic director, or principal of his/her school and have school identification. It is preferred that visiting photographers contact the PISD athletic office prior to the game to expedite the approval process (contact Max Bledsoe @ 214-796-8935 or [jmbledsoe@prosper-isd.net](mailto:jmbledsoe@prosper-isd.net) ).
- Tunnel crew - allows access to the field but sit in stands for game.

### **No pass needed for:**

- Coaches in school attire needing press box/film deck access
- Coaches' wives and family will use their District Pass for admittance
  - Post-game field access for coaches' family members will be restricted to the northeast corner of the end-zone/visitor's tunnel (must have district pass for access)

### **Will Call:**

- Requested scout/media passes can be picked up at the Home Side Will Call window on the West side of the stadium at Gate A
- Any requested visitor side tickets can be picked up at the Visitor side Will Call window on the East side of the stadium at Gate D



## **FOOTBALL COACHES' INFORMATION**

### **Visiting team host on game night – Tim Hardy**

#### **1. PARKING**

- a. Refer to stadium map for drop-off & parking locations.
- b. Team bus parking located on the North end of the stadium.
- c. Visiting teams will need to use general parking including the tunnel crew.
- d. The tunnel crew will enter the stadium on the far North end by the community room. You will be allowed to back your vehicle into the visiting team tunnel to drop off tunnel and equipment. After dropping off equipment, vehicles should be parked in general parking lot on the North East side of the stadium.

#### **2. TUNNEL CREW**

- a. Tunnel crew will have access to the field pre-game and half-time but will sit in the stands for the game.

#### **3. LOCKER ROOMS**

- a. Visiting teams will access their designated locker room via the east tunnel identified on the stadium map in your packet.
- b. There is a coaches' office with restroom and shower facilities. White boards, markers, and a cooler with water &/or soft drinks will be provided.
- c. A game clock is provided in the locker room for your convenience.

#### **4. ATHLETIC TRAINERS**

- a. Any athletic training equipment can be brought to the field through the visitor's tunnel. The visiting team host will direct you to the unloading zone and to your parking location.
- b. A taping room with four taping tables and an evaluation table is available. No AT supplies are

#### **5. PRESS BOX/FILM DECK:**

- a. Admittance requires a pass, or coaching attire.
- b. No more than 4 scouts per school. Scouting is permitted up to two weeks in advance of your competition.
- c. Scouting teams that do not reserve in advance are not guaranteed press-box/film deck space.
- d. Media and scouts must have a pass for entrance.
- e. Access granted via the south elevator located on the home side concourse.

#### **6. SIDELINE PASSES:**

- a. No pass needed for personnel in coaches' staff attire.
- b. Only authorized personnel, news media, or photographers with passes will be allowed on the field or in the team area. No media personnel will be granted locker room access.

**All media and scouts must obtain passes from the PISD Athletic offices. For authorization, contact Max Bledsoe at 214-796-8935 or [jmbledsoe@prosper-isd.net](mailto:jmbledsoe@prosper-isd.net) prior to game day.**

**RULES:**

- a. All team personnel must be in coaching attire or uniform.
- b. All others must have an authorized pass for sideline access.
- c. No food, drink, gum, candy, or seeds on the field.
- d. EMT personnel will handle all medical emergencies.
- e. In the event of an Emergency Evacuation, refer to the "Evacuation Plan".



## PROSPER ISD STADIUM EVACUATION PLAN

1. Police will notify the Athletic Director and Assistant Athletic Director that the stadium needs to be evacuated.
2. The public-address announcer will then be notified to make the announcement to evacuate the stadium.
3. The teams will be sent to the dressing rooms.
4. Patrons on the home side and visitor's sides will be put on the concourse or be allowed to leave to their cars.
5. Stadium workers on both the home and visitor side will evacuate all spectators and continue to maintain order.
6. Ticket takers on both home and visitors side will go into the ticket storage room in the athletic office.
7. Bands, dance teams and cheerleaders should exit at the field level and to their buses, if deemed safe.
8. Communication will be given via radio. Once the "All Clear" is given, people will be released in the same direction as they entered their areas of safety.
