CLUBS & ORGANIZATIONS RULES

1. All clubs and organizations must be approved through the Prosper High School Administration office. Clubs and organizations must have operating documents such as a constitution, by-laws, etc. approved and on file with Prosper High School Administration that are in line with the rules stated herein.
2. All clubs and organizations must have a current Prosper High School staff member as sponsor who is approved by Prosper High School Administration.
3. Prosper High School Club and organization membership must be open only to all current, actively-enrolled Prosper High School students. *Membership shall not be denied except by Administrative decision based upon documented behavioral violations interfering with the normal functioning of the club or organization's activities.
**exceptions to this rule are clubs or organizations that are a part of a state or national system that require delimitation of membership based on various qualifications. i.e. National Honor Society, Mu Theta Alpha, etc. Rules for these clubs and organizations must be submitted separately and approved by Prosper High School Administration.
4. All advertising or promotion for clubs and organizations at Prosper High School must be approved by Prosper High School Administration. Club and organization sponsors may post a meeting notification up to two weeks before the next scheduled meeting on the Sponsor's classroom door. Clubs and Organizations may also advertise their meeting day and time through staff sponsor notification to the Assistant Principal's office to be placed on the Prosper High School Twitter page. The staff sponsor may also turn in an announcement for Eagle Nation News about the meeting day and time. No other posters, stickers, fliers or other advertisement shall be placed around the Prosper High School campus nor outside of the school without approval from Prosper High School Administration.
5. Clubs and organizations at Prosper High School may wish to have their own social media page to promote meetings, events, and activities planned for the club or organization. This page must go through the Prosper ISD approval process and postings must be monitored and maintained by the Prosper High School staff sponsor.
6. Club and organization events and activities must be approved by Prosper High School Administration and shall not create a disruption to the educational environment of the school.
